But some stakeholders expressed their support for the project. The Residential and Civil Construction Alliance of Ontario (RCCAO) commissioned an economic impact report that found the Highway 413 project would support up to 8,000 jobs annually over a five-year period during construction. "Establishing this transportation corridor is a forward-thinking mix of transit and transportation infrastructure that the province needs for its future growth," said RCCAO executive director **Nadia Todorova**.
