RCCAO Welcomes Federal Government's Infrastructure Funding Agreement for Ontario's Municipalities

Statement by Residential and Civil Construction Alliance of Ontario (RCCAO) Executive Director, Nadia Todorova, in response to the new Canada Community-Building Fund (CCBF) agreement:

“RCCAO welcomes news that all three levels of government have finalized an agreement through the Canada Community-Building Fund (CCBF) that will see Ontario’s municipalities receive \$4.7 billion in infrastructure funding over 5 years.”

“This funding is crucial for municipalities across Ontario who are facing a growing and unsustainable state of good repair backlog. The City of Toronto alone faces an alarming \$26 billion shortfall that, if unaddressed, would carry devastating consequences for quality of life and economic growth.”

“RCCAO has been a leading advocate for the federal government to come to the table and provide municipalities with funding to address infrastructure’s state of good repair. In 2023, RCCAO released a [groundbreaking report](#) that revealed the federal government is underfunding municipalities and public infrastructure, while reaping the largest proportion of tax dollars from high-tax policies on homebuilding.”

“While this announcement is a move in the right direction, it is critical that governments continue to provide long-term infrastructure funding that supports the needs of our growing province for decades to come.”
